The family brought Andra home Sunday.

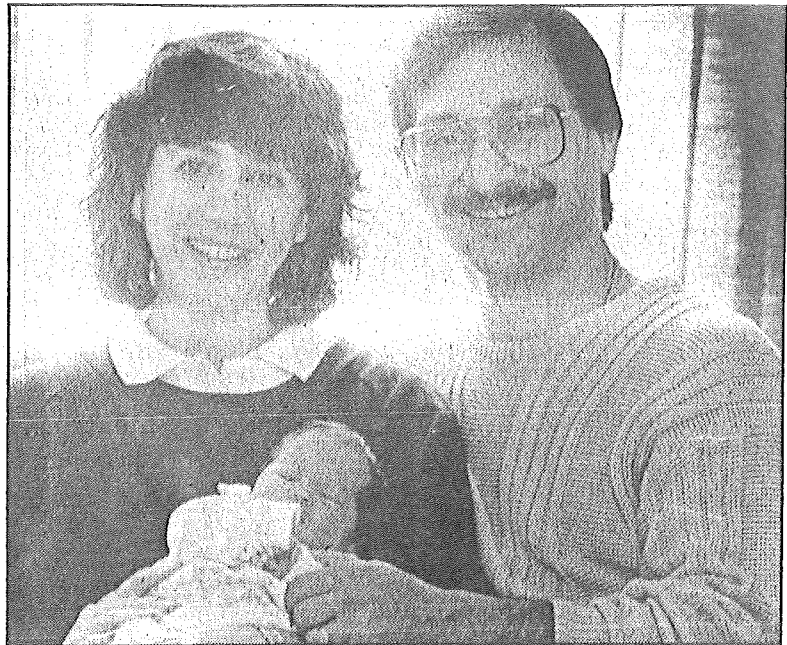
