Mississauga real estate broker Lou Parsons' name has been nominated by city council for the Ontario Solicitor General's annual awards for crime prevention.

Council passed a motion nominating Parsons for his "outstanding contribution" as chairman of the Peel Crime Stoppers unit which was formed last March.

Parsons was the first chairman of the Region of Peel when it was formed in 1974 and is a former Mississauga councillor. He is currently chairman of GO Transit and is a past president of the Mississauga City Board of Trade.
