For the past 13 years Lou Parsons has been in charge of making sure buses and trains run safely. Now, he is go to help improve the traffic safety awareness for the children of Peel Region

Parsons, until recently chairman of GO Transit and a former chairman of Peel Region, has been named chairman of Fund Development for the Peel Children's Safety Village.

The project, involving local governments, schools boards and police forces, is designed to teach traffic safety to children through the use of a miniature village that includes buildings, and real traffic lights, signs, roads and an operational railway crossing.

As chairman of the Fund Development, Parsons will be in charge of raising \$400,000 needed to complete construction.
