

Mississauga heritage expert passes away

Betty Rothwell, a veteran of Mississauga's heritage advisory committee, died last week.

Rothwell had served on Mississauga's Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee (LACAC) since 1978. She was both chairman and vice-chairman of the

group, which advises city council on heritage matters.

Mayor Hazel McCallion, who attended the Sunday funeral along with Ward 9 Councillor Ted Southorn, told council Monday that Rothwell "was a person who gave very generously to the Town-

ship of Toronto, the Town of Mississauga, and the City of Mississauga."

Rothwell worked with the township's industrial commission at one time.

"It's a great loss to LACAC," McCallion said.
