New chief for HUDAC

William E. Small, a Mississauga builder and developer, has been named the 1978 president of the Housing and Urban Development Association of Canada (HUDAC).

Small is president of Glen Leven Properties Ltd. and New Peel Development Corp. Ltd.

He is the fourth Mississauga builder-developer to hold the position in the last 25 years. In 1953-54, Gordon Shipp, now chairman of the board, Shipp Corp. Ltd., served as president, followed in 1970 by S. Eric Johnson, president, S. Eric Johnson Ltd.

Harold Shipp, president of the Shipp Corp. Ltd., was HUDAC president in 1971.

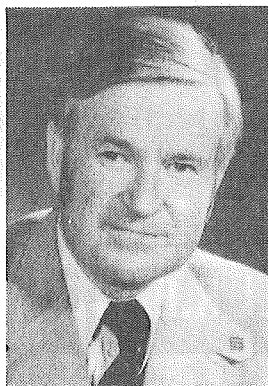
Small has been building and developing in southern Ontario for 30 years, and is currently working on the Walden Spinney Development in Mississauga, an innovative project of 700 units of townhouses and apartments.

Small, 50, was president of Toronto Home Builders' Association in 1957 and 1958. During the

next two years he served as chairman of the National Home Show. He was chairman of the HUDAC Ontario Council from 1968 to 1970. He was named HUDAC president at the association's recent convention in Quebec City.

Small is a licensed pilot, and flies his own airplane on many of his business trips and visits to HUDAC member associations. He is a director of the Royal Canadian Flying Clubs' Association and the Brampton Flying Club, and is a member of the Mississauga Rotary Club.
