

## **New business, an old name, in Mississauga**

The son of a former mayor called the shots as a business management company opened in Mississauga last week.

John Speck, son of the late Robert Speck, officiated last week when Midland Walwyn Capital Inc. opened its 73rd office.

Located at 186 Robert Speck Pkwy. — a street named in memory of his father — the new Mississauga office is headed by John Speck, the company's vice-president and general manager.

"Mississauga and Peel Region are the fastest growing areas in Canada," Speck said.

Midland Walwyn boasts many clients from Mississauga.

The new office features 11 financial advisors and five support staff to provide clients with a wide range of investment products and services.

Speck's father was the mayor when the former Toronto Township became the Town of Mississauga in the 1960s. He became famous across Canada as one of the first people to undergo a heart transplant.
