"I want to build on the strong foundation that Community Living has already built," says Tansley of his goals for the future. "I want to make this great organization even stronger."

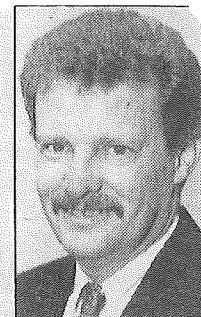
"I have a real need to ensure that intellectually handicapped
