New Mississauga conservation area will be named after Jim Tovey

The late Jim Tovey will have a conservation area named after him, Credit Valley Conservation (CVC) announced Friday (June 2) .The new conservation area being developed along the Mississauga waterfront will be named in honour of the longtime Ward 1 city coun-

Tovey is credited with bringing together the Region of Peel, the CVC and the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority to develop the Lakeview Waterfront Connection, the 26-hecatre waterfront conservation area in Mississauga's Lake-

The exact name of the area will be developed in consultation with Tovey's family, the partners in the project and the community liai-



son committee.

"Jim imagined a different path forward for the Lakeview waterfront, where residents can enjoy the waterfront experience and the natural environment can thrive," said Ward 7 Coun. Nando Iannicca, CVC chair, in a news release.
