Peel clerk Trouten B.C. bound

After almost six years as regional clerk and director of administration, Deborah Trouten is leaving the Region of Peel.

Trouten will be heading west to become director of communications and public education for the Greater Vancouver Regional Government, which encompasses 18 municipalities in surrounding Vancouver, British Columbia.

Trouten says the area will have an eventual population of 1.6 million people and delivers many of the same services she's worked with in Peel.

The change marks a return to her original discipline of communications. Trouten has a master's degree in the subject and has been active for many years in the Public Relations Society of Canada.

She was appointed regional clerk in November 1988. She began her career with Peel in 1983 and spent three years as executive assistant to the Chief Administrative Officer. She then moved on to Bell Canada in public relations.
