Helen Tucker Now a super Rul Bray - Br world citizen

World Citizen Helen Tucker has a new title. The Mississauga senior is now a world citizen extraordinaire.

A telegram expected to arrive from Paris at Mississauga city hall will make it official. Mrs. Tucker has been elected to a parliamentary body that many hope will one day form the nucleus of a democratic world government. She is one of only 12 persons elected to the World Citizens' Peoples' Congress since its inception in 1969.

Mrs. Tucker says she is proud to spread the word about world citizenship—a concept that began as the brainchild of 13 Nobel Prize winners.

The Douglas Rd. resident promises to use her new position to introduce world citizenship to Canadian youth. The schools, she says, are the ideal place to teach young

people tolerance for others' customs and religions, and to encourage shared responsibility for world peace.

Election to world government is not an overnight affair. The actual balloting takes six months. Mrs. Tucker has led at the polls since July.
