

# Turnbull celebrates birthday

Barbara Turnbull celebrated her 19th birthday quietly with just her immediate family yesterday but her fellow Clarkson Secondary School students were with her in spirit.

A cake baked by members of a Grade 9 class, hundreds of notes and cards and a huge card signed by students were delivered to Sunnybrook Medical Centre for Barbara to enjoy with her family.

Barbara was sent back to Sunnybrook from the Lyndhurst paraplegic rehabilitation facility last week after she developed complications. Her mother Iris said she's fighting a virus following a bout with the flu, not uncommon with paralyzed patients.

Meanwhile, fundraising efforts for Barbara's medical expenses and living costs continue in Mississauga and the surrounding area. A recent dance put on by the Clarkson Rotary Club netted The Barbara Turnbull Fund close to \$7,800 and money continues to pour in from a specially set up postal box number. To date, the fund has \$183,069 in its coffers.
