Local artist Wendy Whitmore has involved herself in three artistic events for May and June.

She will be the guest artist at the Springbank Visual Arts Centre's Studio Tour, May 19 and 20. The tour is designed to spark interest in Mississauga's artists and there will be 12 prominent artists involved featuring pottery, sculpture, weaving, printmaking, basketry, silk painting and doll making.

Tickets are \$15 for a map to the studios and a buffet lunch. The tour is sponsored by Visual Arts Mississauga.

The local watercolorist will also host an open house at the Springbank Visual Art Centre, May 26-28, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. The solo show is sponsored by Visual Arts Mississauga, is open to the public, and admission is free. Ward 2 councillor Pat Mullin will attend the official opening Friday, May 26 at 8 p.m.

Visual Arts Mississauga will also sponsor a workshop Whitmore will give, June 12-16, also at Springbank.

Whitmore works from a home studio and her original paintings range in price from \$200 to \$1,500. She's an independent fine artist who works primarily in pure watercolor, but also dabbles in acrylic.
