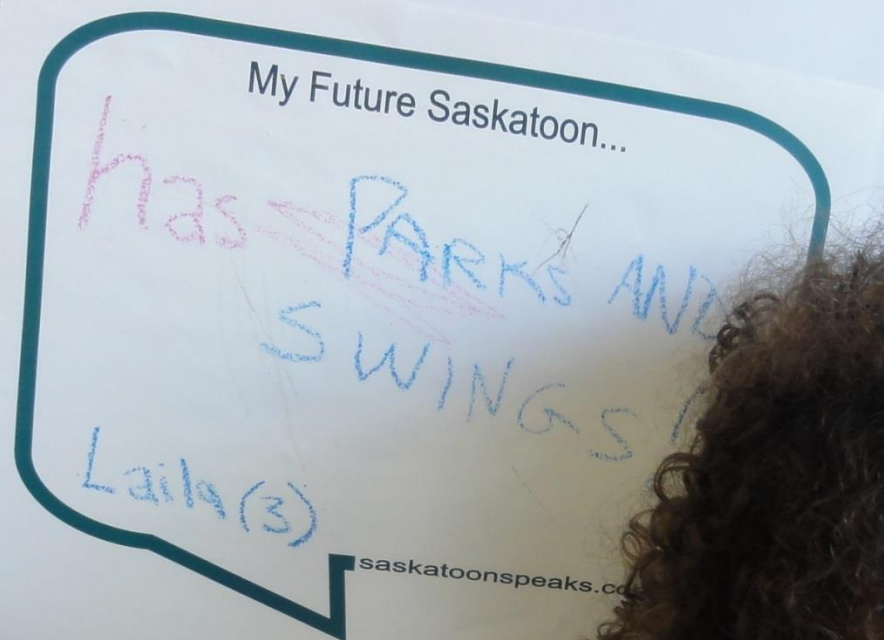

Recreation and Parks Projects

- Wildwood Park
Replanting of trees ongoing since Fall 2014, new Master Plan for the Park to commence in late 2016
- Malton Village Park
Construction has commenced, anticipated completion Fall 2015

Ongoing - Public Engagement happening with Malton Community Plan Review
- The “Story of M” Project
Spring/Fall 2015

Transportation and Works Projects

- Torbram Road CNR Underpass
Construction commenced January 2015, anticipated completion is 2 years
- Goreway Drive CNR Overpass
City of Brampton is the proponent for this project, acquisition of property underway
- Malton Flood Management Study
Toronto and Region Conservation Authority is the proponent. Commenced in early 2014, completion date is not yet determined

Other

- Malton Walkability Audit
Region of Peel is the proponent, audit anticipated in Summer 2015
- Malton Community Building Project
Completed with new Future Directions Steering Committee created

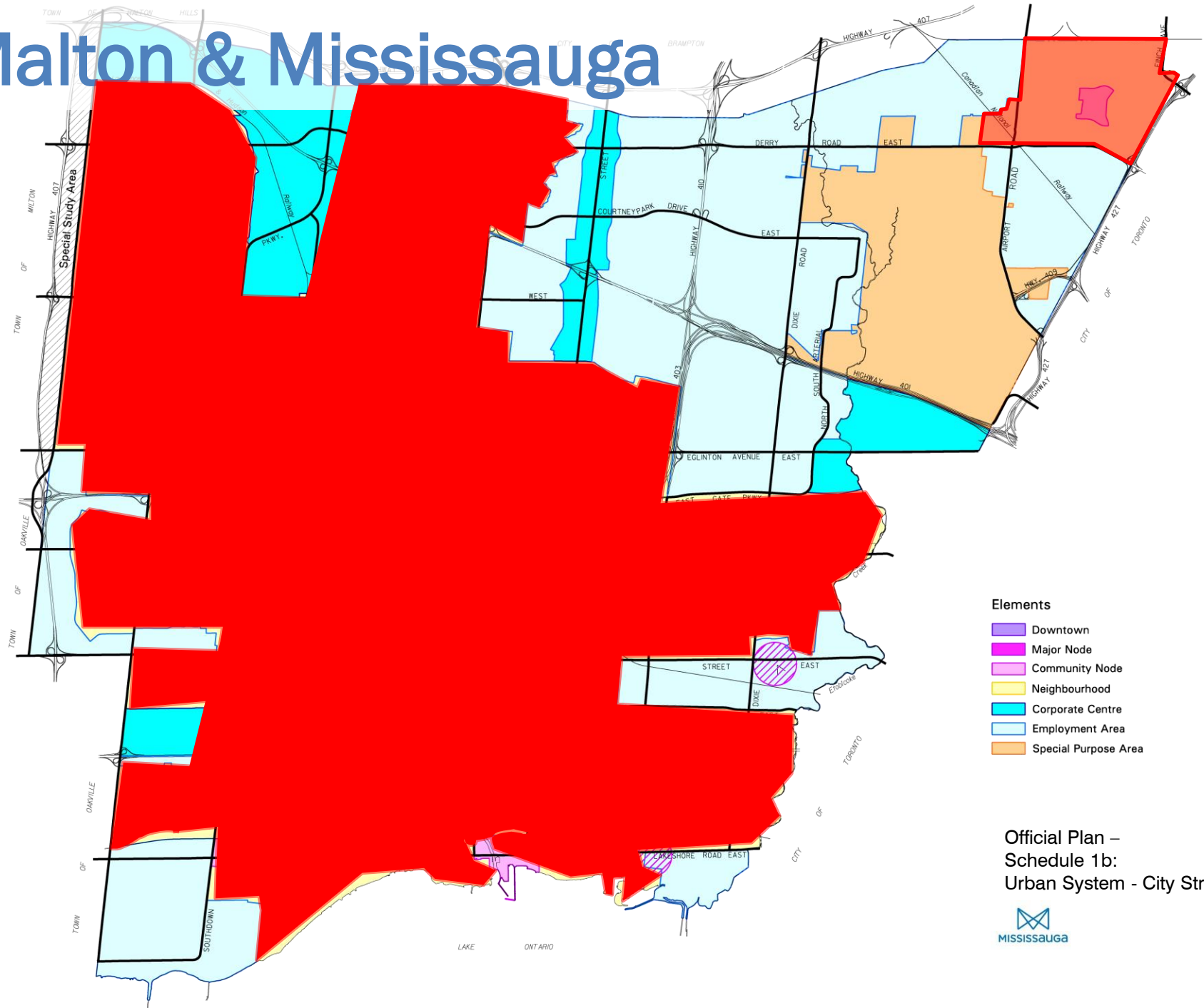

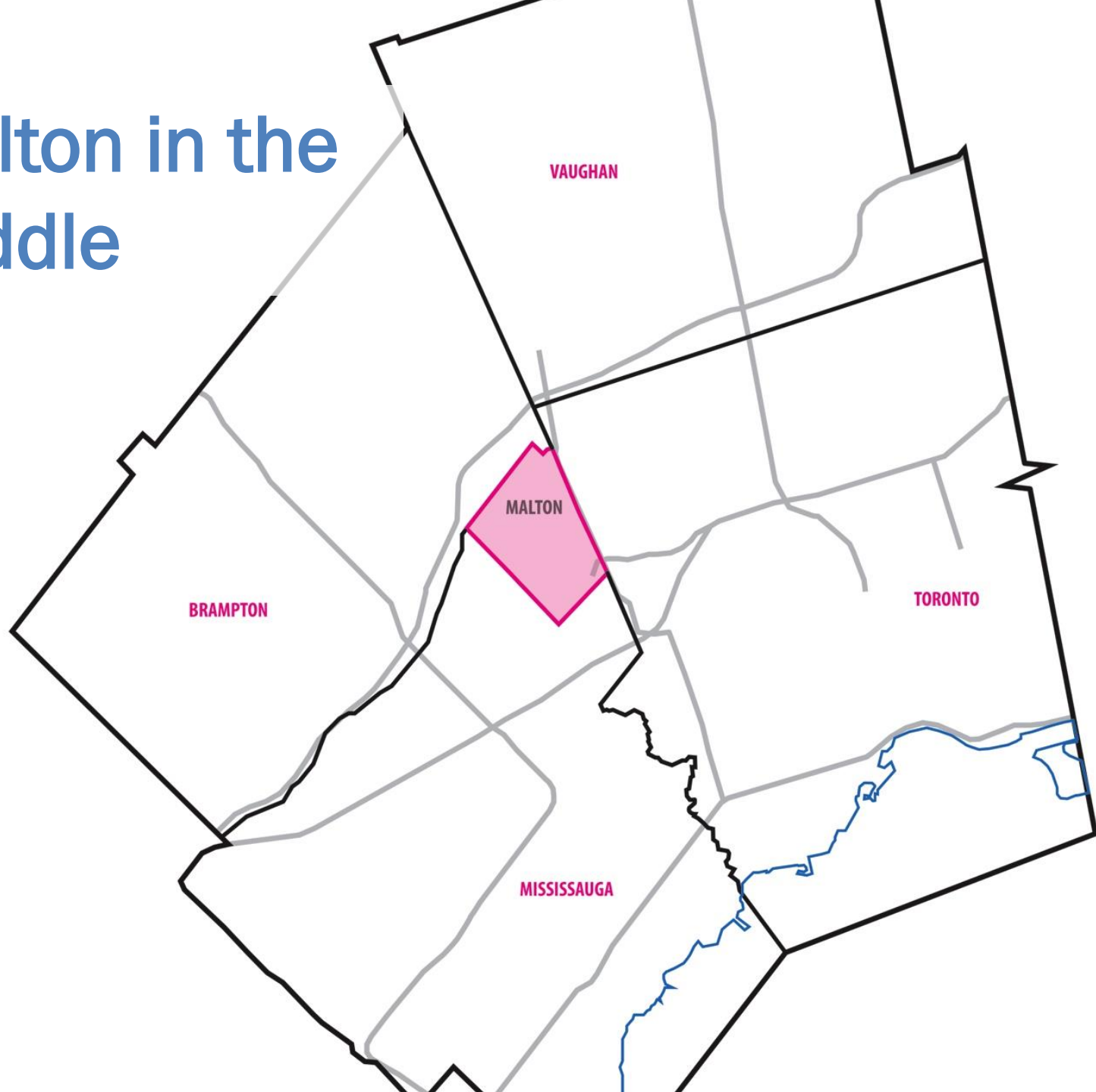

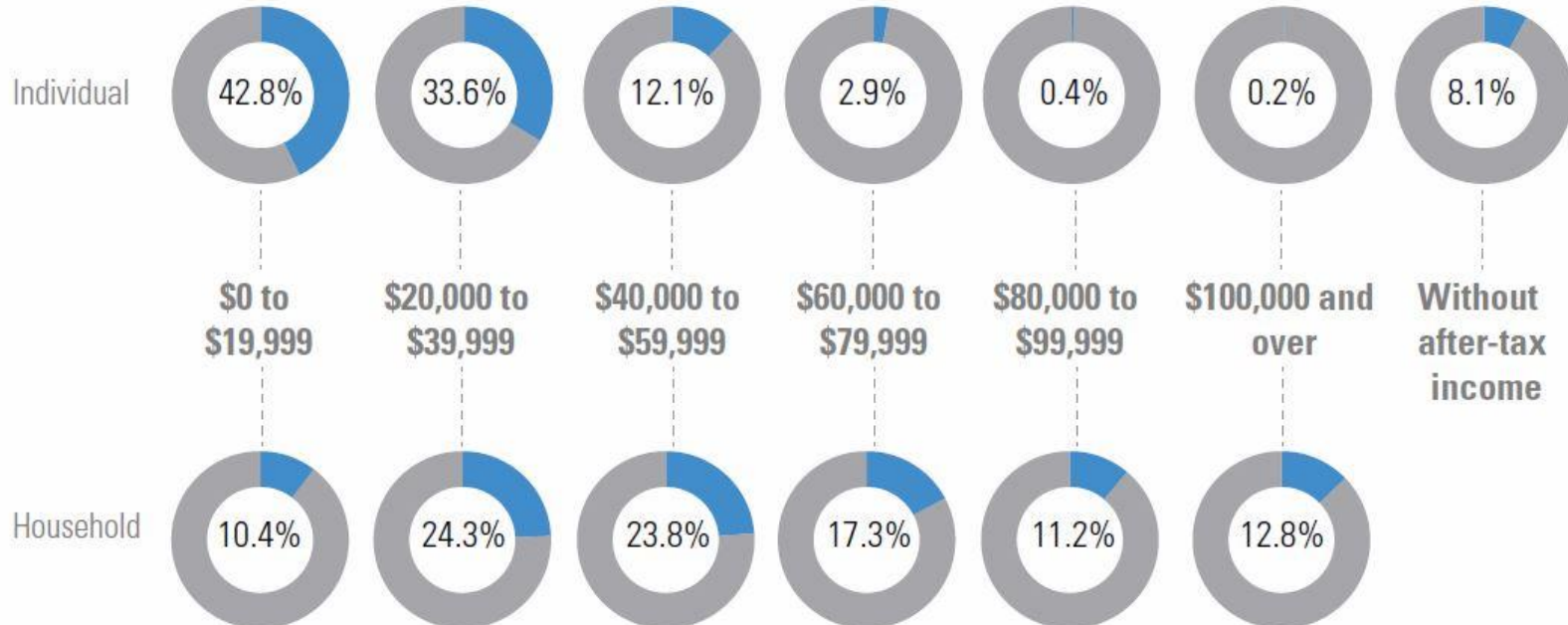
Malton in the Middle

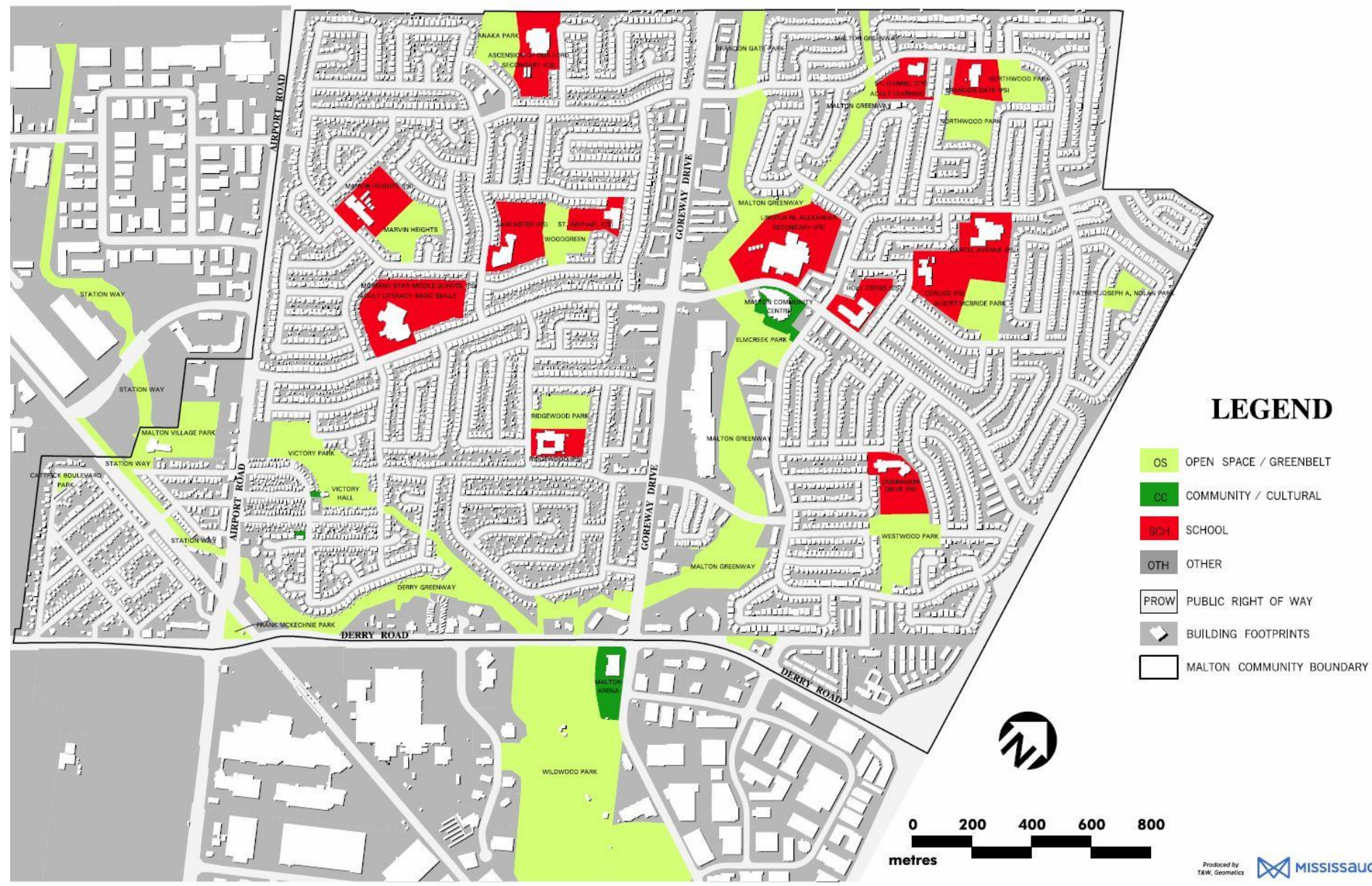

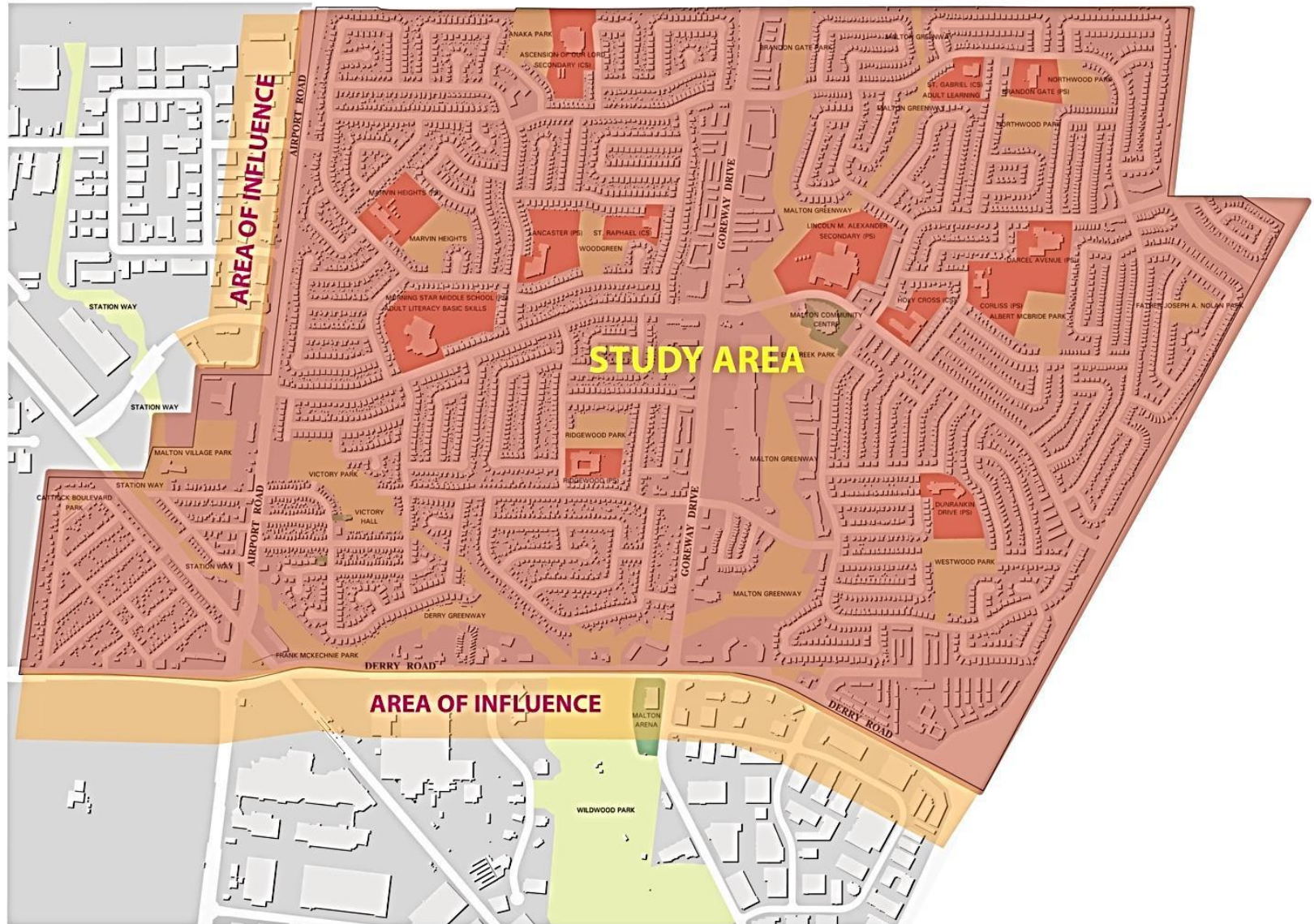

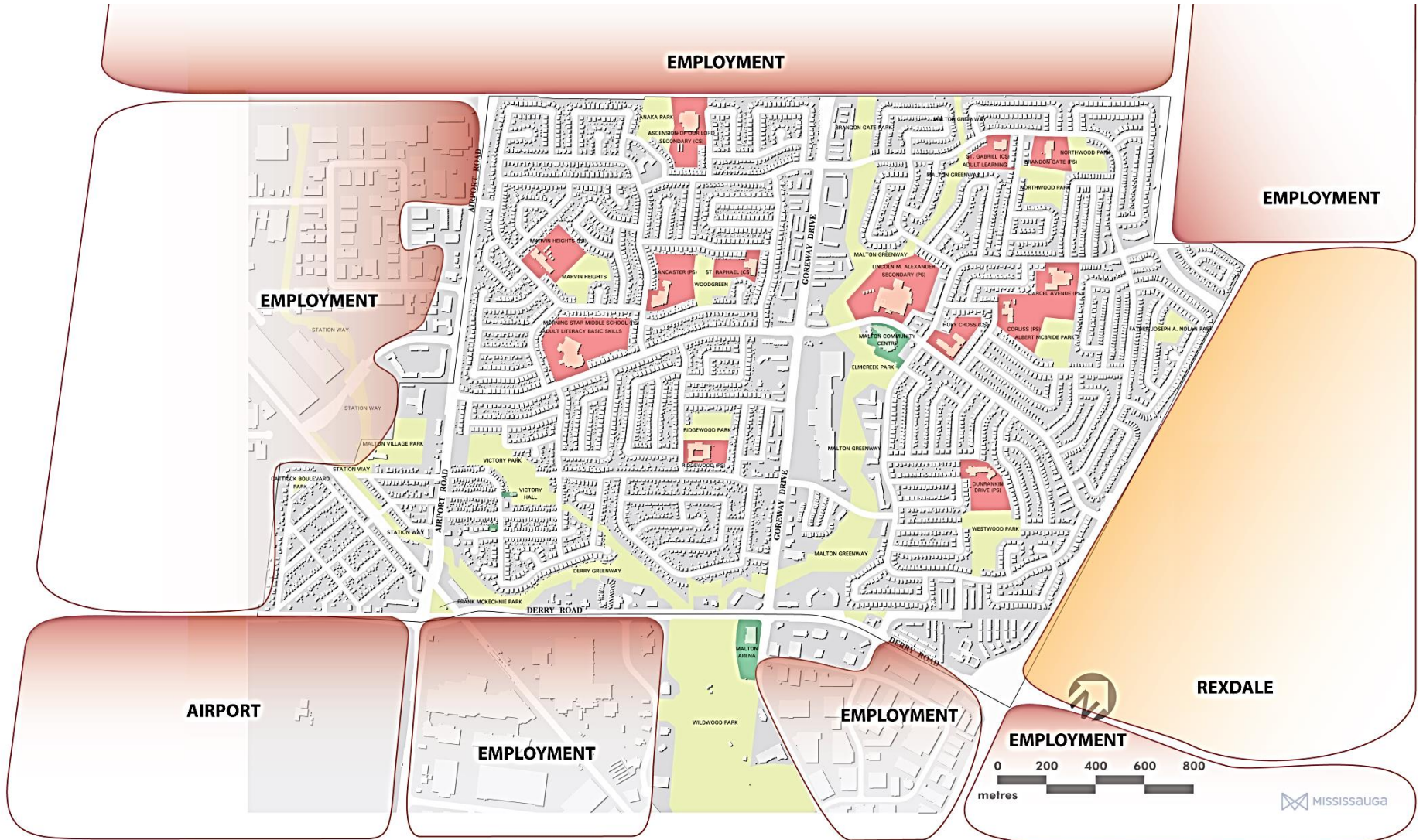
Malton Base Map



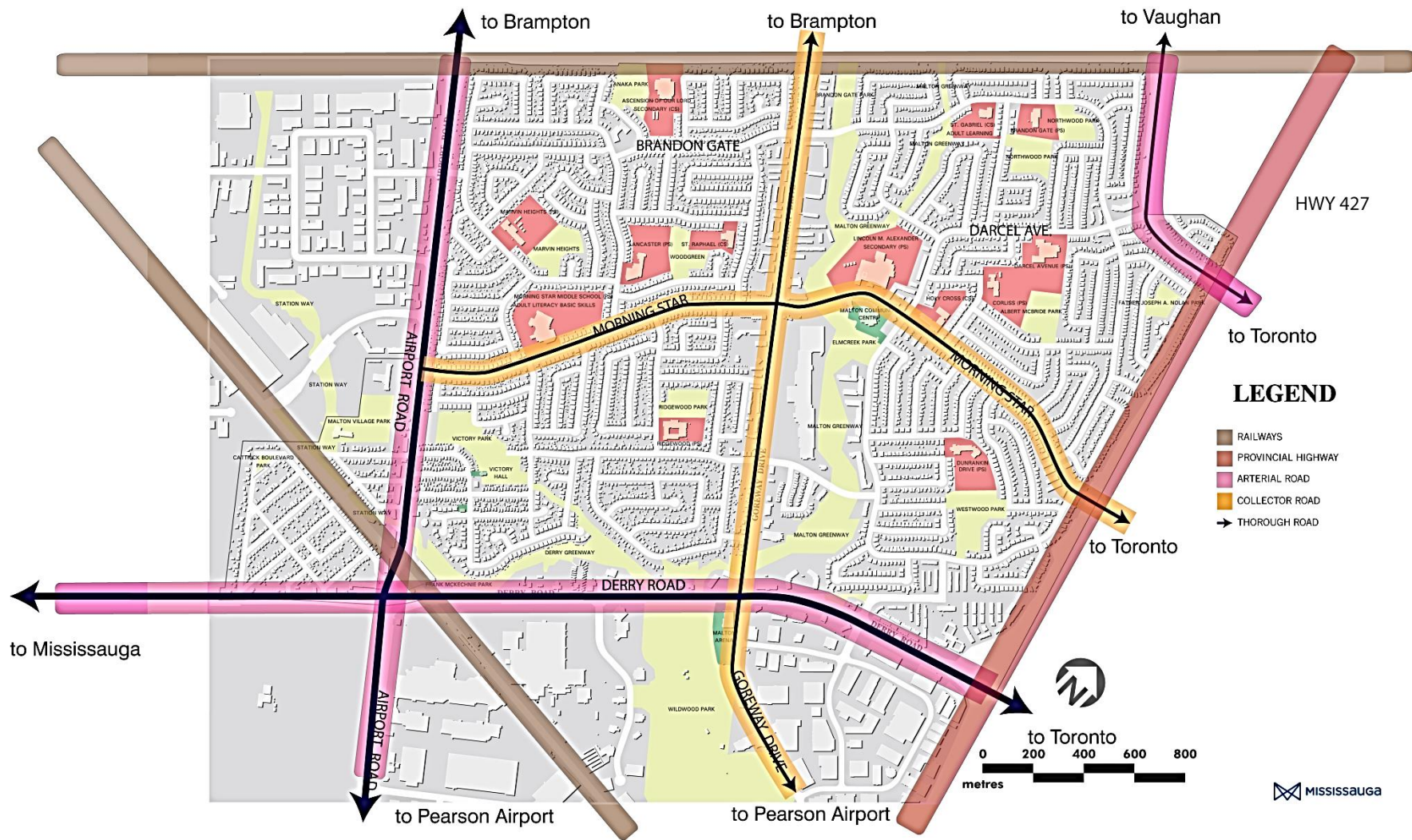
MyMalton Study Area



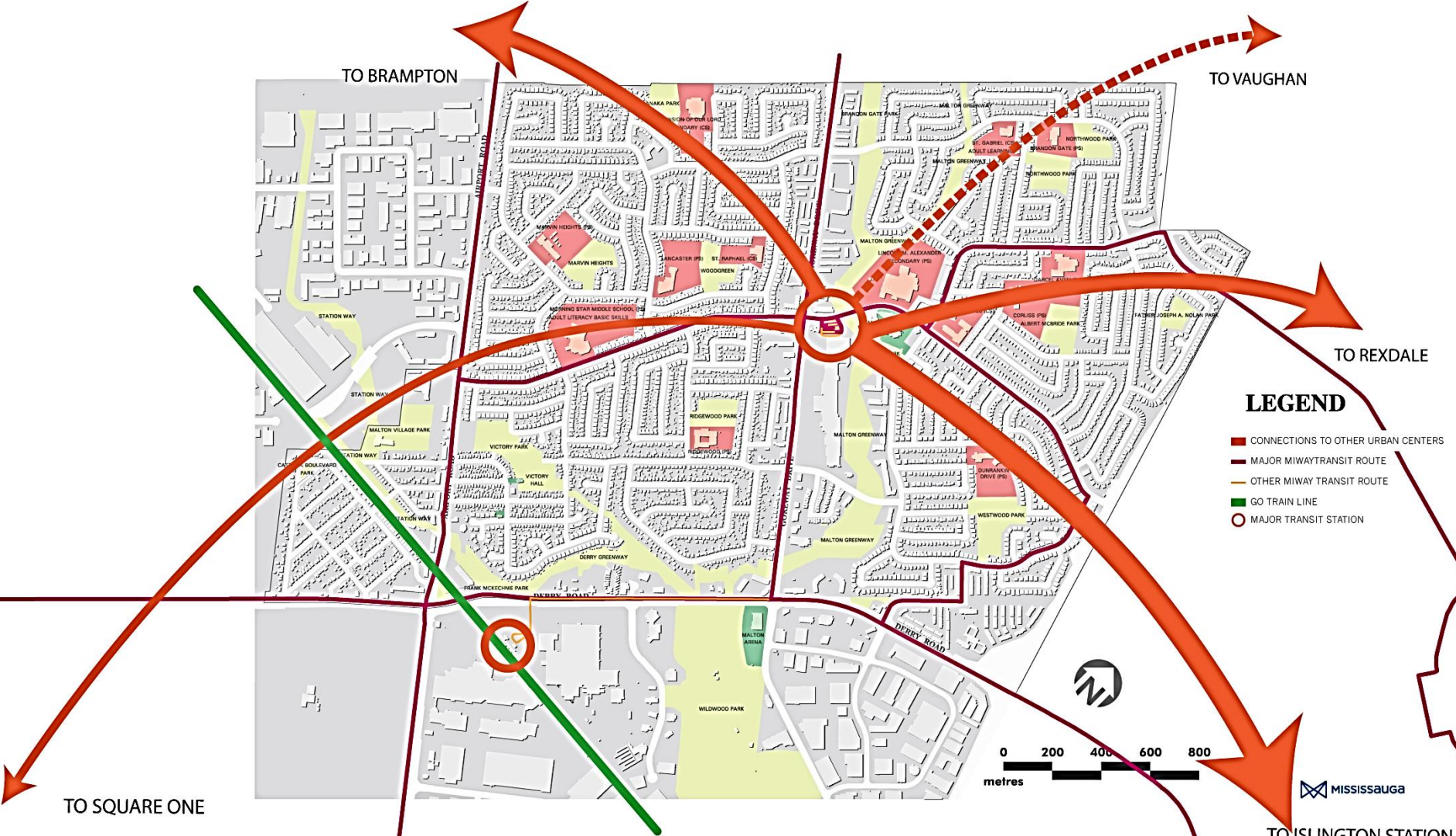
There is some truth to Malton's isolation



Major Roads/Railways Reinforce Barriers



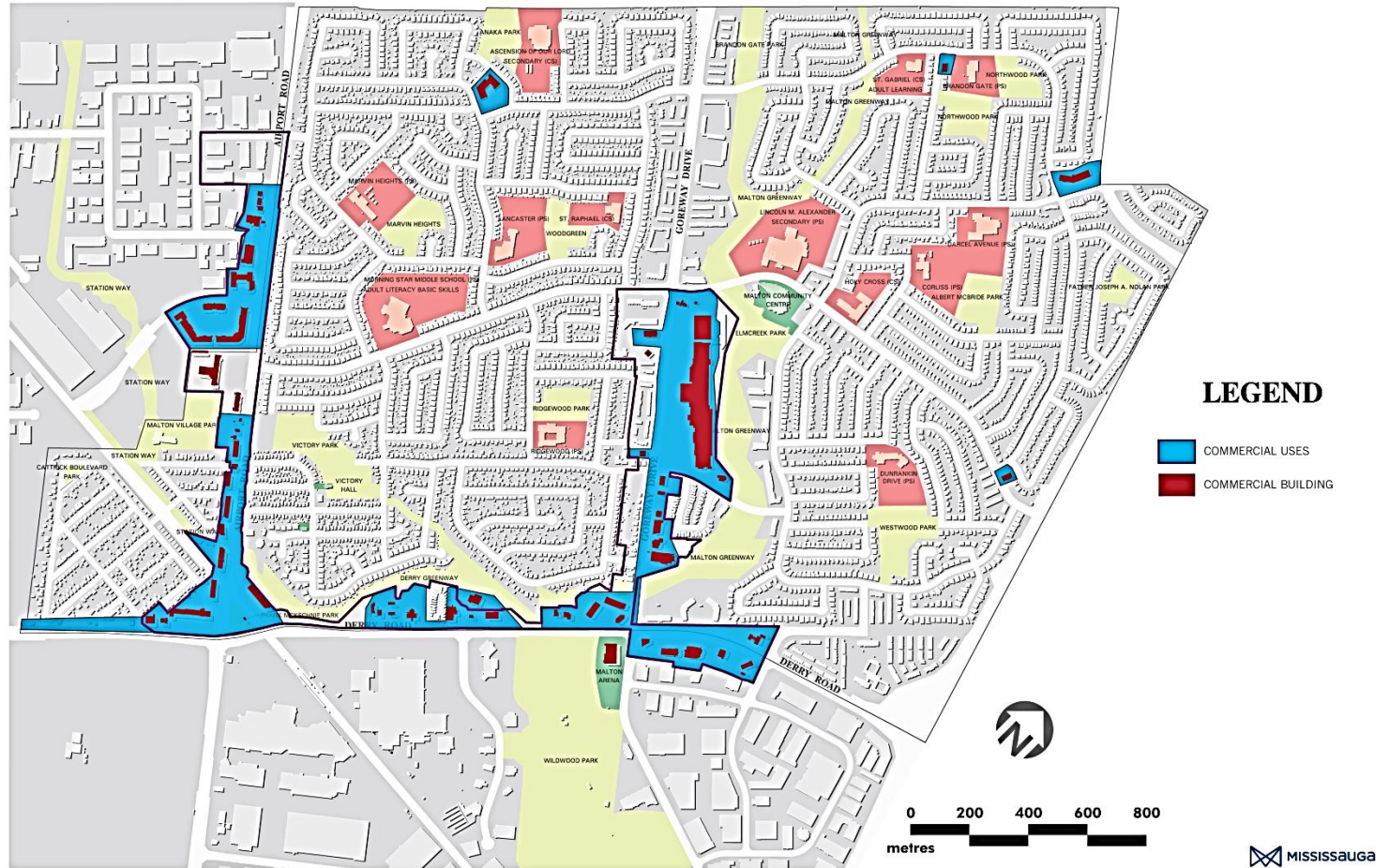
But connections exist in many directions

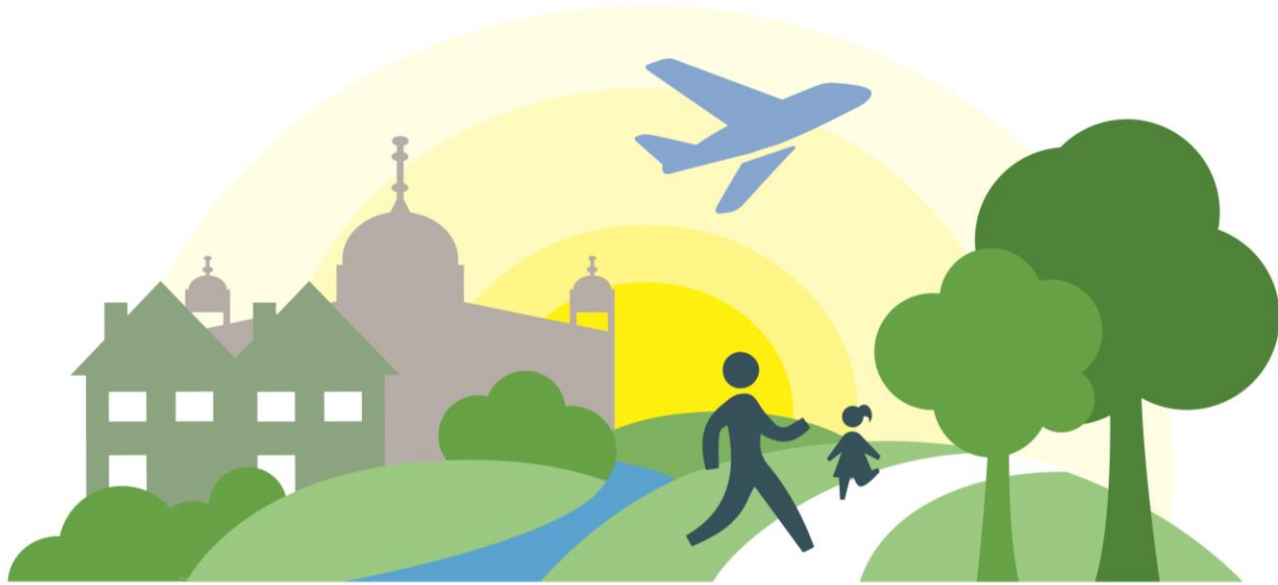
