Benefits of grasscycling

- Leave mowed grass on your lawn to break down naturally.
- Conserve water and enrich your soil.
- Save time, money and effort.

Did you know?

- Nutrients are supplied to the soil by clippings left on your lawn.
- Grass clippings contain 80% - 85% water and break down quickly.

Grasscycling tips:

- Consider investing in a mulching mower.
- Keep blades sharp. Dull blades can harm grass.
- Keep your grass tall to minimize heat damage to the roots and decrease water loss.
- Cut grass often and trim in the evening. Smaller clippings break down faster.
- Mow when dry as clippings spread more evenly and break down faster.

You can also consider:

- Using a backyard composter. Composters are sold at Peel Community Recycling Centres.
- Reducing your lawn area by creating a fusion garden. Check watersmartpeel.ca/fusion for tips.
