

Green Bin, Blue Box & Plastic Garbage Receptacle Take-Back Events

The Region does not collect old, obsolete green bins, blue boxes, grey boxes or plastic resin containers at the curb.

Choose from these options to dispose of your old bins and containers:



1. Bring them to a free take-back event

Take-back events will take place on designated dates in July & August.

Acceptable items include:

- **Recycling Boxes:** The blue or grey recycling boxes have been in used since the mid 1980's. They range in volumes from 12 US Gallons (45.42 litres) to 17 US Gallons (63.59 litres).

- **Organic Bins:** The green organic bins have a capacity of 12 US Gallons (45.42 litres). They have a hinged lid, carry handles and two wheels.
- **Kitchen Containers:** The kitchen container is used in the home to collect organic material and is cream in colour. The container has a capacity of 7 litres, and dimensions are 32cm x 22cm x 22cm. It has a hinged attached lid and a carrying handle.
- **Plastic Waste Containers:** Plastic waste containers may have a detachable lid, handles (molded or non-molded) and may also have wheels.

New waste carts will not be accepted.

2. Drop them off for free at a **Peel Community Recycling Centre (CRC)**.

At the CRC, be sure to dispose of your bins and/or boxes in the designated section, not in the garbage receptacle.

3. Keep and re-use them.

- Use your old green bin to store pet food, bird seed, barbeque charcoal, sand or sidewalk salt.
- Use your old blue box or grey box to:
 - Hold recyclables before putting them in your recycling cart.
 - Hold yard waste for setting on the curb. A blue/grey box **must be clearly labelled** with a yard waste sticker or “Yard Waste” clearly written in paint or permanent marker.
 - Store items around your home or in your shed or garage.

Watch the options available to you for your existing bins and containers.
