CREDIT VALLEY ROAD TRAFFIC CALMING

The City of Mississauga has recently begun implementing physical traffic calming measures in order to address local neighbourhood road safety issues in Mississauga.

Through an extensive review process, roadways are identified to receive physical traffic calming measures. Credit Valley Road between Winston Churchill Boulevard and Erin Mills Parkway has been selected as a location which would benefit from the installation of traffic calming measures.

What is Traffic Calming?

Traffic calming consists of physical measures (speed humps, speed cushions) put in place on the road in order to reduce the speed and volume of traffic and to restore neighbourhood roadways to their intended function.

At this time, staff would like to invite you to a public information centre which will provide background information on Traffic Calming including the proposed traffic calming measures for Credit Valley Road. The representatives from the City will be present to answer questions and discuss the details of the proposed plan and installation of traffic calming afterwards.
