Re: Trapper's Green Park Redevelopment

Dear Neighbours,

As I'm sure many of you have seen construction begin at Trapper's Green Park, I am pleased to report that Trapper's Green Park is one of the projects in Ward 8 that received Canada 150 Infrastructure funding.

The Canada 150 playgrounds are being designed to commemorate Canada's 150th Anniversary, and is being funded in part through the Canada 150 Infrastructure Program (CIP). Trapper's Green is being redeveloped as part of this program, with the goals of:

- making playgrounds accessible
- updating to current industry standards
- promoting outdoor physical fitness in support of healthy lifestyles and active living
- making playgrounds family oriented

The works include:

- Life cycle replacement of all play equipment
- Accessibility improvements, sand surface replacement with engineered wood fiber and paved pathway connections
- Sand pit
- Seating area
- Outdoor fitness area

Please see the rendering of what the new play area will look like. Our targeted completion date is October 10th pending no weather delays.
