

## **Skaters Code of Conduct:**

- Please listen to and obey skate patrollers at all times
- Please do not bring food or drink on the ice surface
- Skate in the approved direction only. Do not skate backwards
- All participants must be in full control and be able to avoid contact with other skaters - No horseplay/games
- Please do not skate excessively fast or erratically
- No hockey equipment or other toys/equipment are permitted on the ice surface
- Only approved skate aid devices will be permitted
- Please do not stand/rest on the ice surface
- Please do not carry children while skating
- Please leave the ice surface immediately when asked to do so by the skate patrollers
- The use of CSA approved hockey helmets by all participants is strongly recommended
- All participants must wear ice skates (excluding those in wheelchairs/sledges)

### **Approved Skating Aids permitted during public skate times:**

- Wheelchairs (persons accompanying a participant in a wheelchair must wear ice skates)
- E-Z Gliders
- Sledges

### **Restricted Aids:**

- Strollers
- Chairs
- Other equipment not specifically designed as a skating aid
