

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO AMEND BY-LAW 521-77 PER THE

ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, AND IN THE MATTER OF THE LANDS AND PREMISES LOCATED AT 41 MILL STREET (also known as TIMOTHY STREET HOUSE) IN THE CITY OF MISSISSAUGA, IN THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO, designating these lands and premises as having design/physical; historical/associative; and, contextual cultural heritage value and interest under Ontario Regulation 9/06 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter O.18, as amended.

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Mississauga intends to amend designation by-law 521-77 designating the Property under Part IV, Section 30.1 (1) of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 0.18, as amended, including all the buildings and structures thereon as being of cultural heritage value or interest. The purpose of this amendment is to reflect the Property's revised legal description per Council's adoption of General Committee Recommendation GC-0385-2014, "that a portion of City owned lands located on the south side of Mill Street...be declared surplus to the City's requirements."; and, to reflect the Property's cultural heritage values and attributes as set out in the 2005 amendments to the Ontario Heritage Act.
