

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO AMEND BY-LAW 368-82 PER THE ONTARIO

HERITAGE ACT, AND IN THE MATTER OF THE LANDS AND PREMISES LOCATED AT 5155 MISSISSAUGA ROAD (also known as WILLIAM BARBER HOUSE) IN THE CITY OF MISSISSAUGA, IN THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO, designating these lands and premises as having design/physical; historical/associative; and, contextual cultural heritage value and interest under Ontario Regulation 9/06 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 0.18, as amended. ("Ontario Heritage Act")

Description of Property

The property is located at 5155 Mississauga Road, and it includes the Barber Villa, a 19th century large brick building, in the Regular Villa style, a secondary brick outbuilding, and has a prominent setback from the roads. The property's designation by-law is being amended to better recognize its physical, design, historical, associative and contextual value as per Regulation 9/06 of the Ontario Heritage Act.
