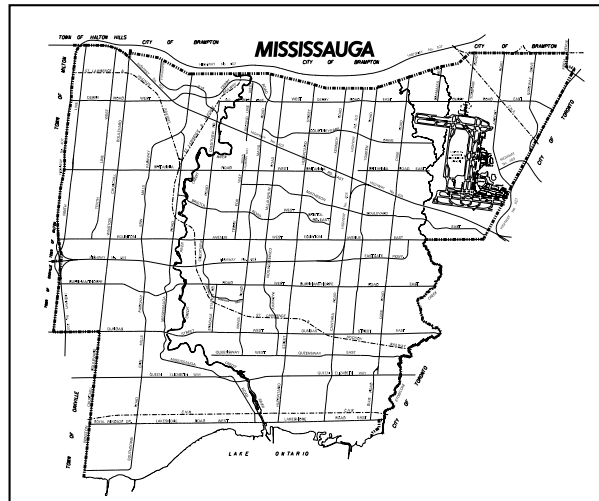

Location of the Proposal



City's Proposal:

To revise the zoning regulations for accessory buildings and structures on residential lots. Proposed revisions include creating two sets of regulations depending on the size of the lot; permitting an increased height and area occupied for larger lots; introducing a maximum lot coverage for accessory structures; removing the maximum number of accessory structures in favour of a maximum combined area; and exempting certain outdoor fireplaces.

Information about Appeals:

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of City Council to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal, or be added as a party to an appeal of the decision to the Tribunal.

The decision of City Council is final if a notice of appeal is not received on or before the last day for filing a notice of appeal.
