APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- In accordance with the City's Erosion & Sediment Control By-law No. 512-91, as amended, an
 Erosion & Sediment Control Permit must be obtained prior to undertaking any land disturbing
 activities on sites one (1) hectare in size or greater, or on sites of any size that are adjacent to a
 body of water. Please refer to the Erosion & Sediment Control By-law ("the By-law") for details
 concerning permit application requirements.
- 2. Applications for an Erosion & Sediment Control Permit are submitted to the Environmental Services Section of the City's Transportation & Works Department.

The application form must be accompanied with the following:

- a) Five (5) copies of a Control Plan in accordance with Section 6 of the By-law.
- b) An application fee as detailed in Schedule 'A' of the By-law.
- c) An irrevocable Letter of Credit covering 100% of the estimated cost of the erosion and sediment control measures as detailed in Schedule 'A' of the By-law.
- d) An owner's authorization (form attached below)
- e) A tree Injury or destruction declaration and questionnaire (form attached below)
- 3. All applications shall meet the erosion and sediment control design guidelines and requirements as set out in Schedule 'B' of the By-law and in the 'Development Requirements Manual' produced by the Transportation & Works Department.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. Upon issuance, the Erosion & Sediment Control Permit is valid for a period of 180 days. The permit may be extended one or more times for an additional 180 days each time. The permit holder must apply for a permit extension 30 days prior to the permit expiring. Additional erosion and sediment control measures and a renewal fee may be required as a condition of the extension, if they are necessary to meet the requirement of the By-law.
- The issuance of an Erosion & Sediment Control Permit does not relieve the applicant's responsibility to obtain all other approvals which may be required by other Governments and Agencies.
- 3. Upon issuance, the Erosion & Sediment Control Permit is subject to the conditions as set out in Schedule 'C' of the By-law.
- 4. Where it is revealed or discovered that the permit holder has provided misleading or false information on an application, the permit issued shall be revoked and the permit shall cease and desist forthwith all operations conducted under the revoked permit.

Important Information

The City of Mississauga has enacted By-law 0254-2012 that requires a Permit to injure or destroy trees on private property within the City. Furthermore a Tree Removal Permission process has also been established in certain circumstances. A Tree Permit is required when three (3) or more trees with a diameter greater than 15 cm (6 in) are proposed to be injured or removed due to owner's desire or in conjunction with a Building Permit, Pool Enclosure Permit, Erosion or Sediment Control

Permit or a Rezoning/Official Plan Amendment. A Tree Removal Permission is required when three (3) or more trees with a diameter greater than 15 cm (6) are proposed to be injured or removed in conjunction with a Site Plan, Consent or Subdivision Applications.
