Permit Application Checklist



Excess Load

To move oversized loads that exceed Ministry of Transportation limits by height, length, width or weight, as set out in the Highway Traffic Act you will require an Excess Load Permit.

Your application package should include:

- ✓ A completed copy of the **Excess Load** application form.
- ✓ A completed Certificate of Insurance-General form showing valid liability insurance with minimum coverage of \$2,000,000 (\$2M) general liability and \$3,000,000 (\$3M) auto coverage. The form must include the original stamp and signature of the applicant's insurance company.

Application Quick Check

Incomplete or inaccurate applications cannot be processed. Please take a moment to review your application for completeness using the list below.

- ✓ Type of permit indicated
- ✓ Combined vehicle and cargo dimensions are complete
- ✓ Route details provided. (Note: Single trip permits should be initiated in the municipality where the trip starts.)
- Region of Peel, City of Brampton and Town of Caledon are all added as additional insured for any 12 month permit applications; OR
- Region of Peel, City of Brampton and/or Town of Caledon are added as additional insured, as required, for single trip permit applications.

Application packages can be submitted via fax, email, regular mail or in person at the Transportation and Works Customer Service Counter (Mon-Fri, 8:30am-4:00pm).
