Permit Application Checklist



Road Occupancy - Service Connection

If you are obstructing or occupying the City's right-of-way to complete work on water, sanitary or stormwater systems you will require a Road Occupancy Permit specific to service connections

<u>Note:</u> All construction work on City of Mississauga property must be undertaken by a City-approved contractor or sub-contractor. Call 905-615-4950 to enquire about becoming an approved contractor.

Your application package should include:

- ✓ A completed copy of the **Road Occupancy Service Connection** application form.
- ✓ A completed **Certificate of Insurance-General** form showing valid liability insurance with minimum coverage of \$5,000,000 (\$5M). The form must be completed by the contractor's Insurance Company and include an original stamp and signature.
- ✓ Two copies of a scalable drawing of the construction areas, preferably with a key map.
- ✓ Copy of "C" Receipt (proof of payment) from the Region of Peel if work includes water or sanitary connection.

Application Quick Check

Incomplete or inaccurate applications cannot be processed. Please take a moment to review your application for completeness using the list below.

- ✓ detailed description of the location
- ✓ boxes checked to indicate impacts to the City's right-of-way
- ✓ overall cut dimensions provided (note: This is also required for directional boring.)
- ✓ accurate number of trenches and number of connections.

Application packages can be submitted via fax, email, regular mail or in person at the Transportation and Works Customer Service Counter (Mon-Fri, 8:30am-4:00pm).
