

CITY OF MISSISSAUGA NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

Lisgar District Pumping Stations Municipal Class Environmental Assessment

The Study

The City of Mississauga has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) to investigate preferred locations and form of Pumping Station(s) within the Lisgar District to reduce the potential for basement water infiltration. The outcome of the Class EA Study determined the Preferred Solution to be a permanent foundation drain collector (FDC) Pumping Station and Utility Trench Dewatering Pumping System located on Black Walnut Trail at Cactus Gate Parkette.

The Process

The Study was carried out in accordance with the requirements for a Schedule 'B' project as described in the Municipal Engineers Association's Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) document (October 2000, as amended to 2015), which is approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. The Study included consultation with interested stakeholders (public, landowners, regulatory agencies, and Indigenous Communities). One Public Information Centre (PIC) was held on June 14, 2018.

Public Review Period

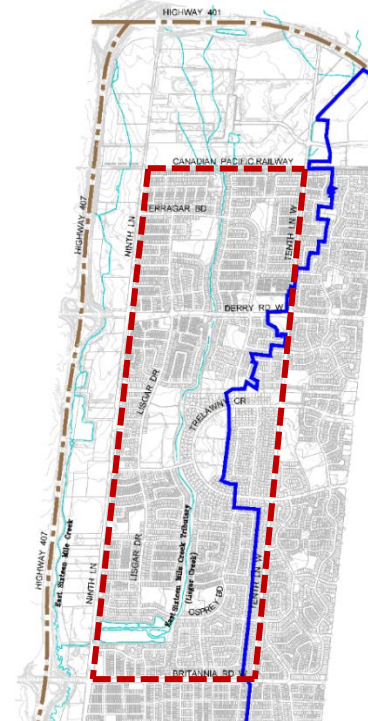
An Environmental Study Report (ESR) has been prepared, which documents; the planning and design process, how public, regulatory agency and Indigenous Community input was addressed, the evaluation and selection of the preferred solution, along with associated mitigation measures to address impacts, and next steps towards project implementation.

The filing of this ESR completes the planning and conceptual design stage of the project. By way of this notice, the ESR is placed on record for a 30-day public review period starting September 13, 2018 and ending on October 13, 2018. Anyone with an interest in this Study is encouraged to review the ESR and provide comments to the City of Mississauga during the designated review period. If concerns arise during the 30-day Review Period that cannot be resolved through discussions with the City of Mississauga, a person may request that the Minister of the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (a Part II order). This request must be received by the Minister in writing within the above noted 30-day timeline at the address listed below and copied to the Director of the Environmental Assessments and Permissions Branch of the MECP, and Louie Jakupi, the City of Mississauga Project Manager. If no request is received, subject to comments, and the receipt of necessary approvals, the City intends to proceed with the project implementation phase.
