INCENTIVES

Funding Initiatives

The Governments of Canada and Ontario offer a variety of funding initiatives specifically tailored to meet the needs of the information & communications technology (ICT) industry.

CareerConnect - Wage Subsidy for

Employers: Helps employers hire eligible unemployed or underemployed graduates in the ICT sector by providing up to \$14,000 for eligible employers.

Industrial Research Assistance Program (IRAP): Provides financial support to gualified small and medium-sized

enterprises in Canada, incorporated and profit-oriented, to help them undertake technology innovation.

Ontario Computer Animation and Special Effects (OCASE) Tax Credit:

A refundable tax credit of 18% of eligible Ontario labour expenditures in the production of computer animation and special effect activities in film or television.

Ontario Emerging Technologies Fund:

A \$250 million fund to co-invest alongside Qualified Investors into innovative, high-growth, private, Ontario companies. The program is designed to respond to the challenges faced in raising capital by innovative, private, Ontario-based companies, including digital media and ICT sectors.

Ontario Film & Television Tax Credit (OFTTC): A refundable tax credit of 35% of the eligible Ontario labour expenditures for a qualifying production company.

Ontario Interactive Digital Media Tax

Credit (OIDMTC): A refundable tax credit of up to 40% of eligible marketing and distribution expenses for the creation of interactive digital media products.

Ontario's R&D Tax Program: Ontario's R&D tax incentive program is widely recognizes as one of the most generous in the world. Combined with federal R&D programs, Ontario's R&D Tax Program can reduce your after-tax cost of every \$100 in R&D spending to between \$61 and \$37.

Scientific Research and Experimental Development (SR&ED) Program: A federal tax incentive program that encourages Canadian businesses of all sizes, and in all sectors to conduct research and development (R&D) in Canada.
