Moved by:

Whereas Health Canada is responsible for issuing licences to persons wishing to cultivate or process cannabis;

AND Whereas the Provincial government is responsible for regulating the sale of recreational cannabis in Ontario and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario has sole responsibility for overseeing the licensing and regulatory framework in regards to the retail sale of recreational cannabis;

AND Whereas this motion only deals with production facilities licensed through Health Canada and does not include retail sales;

AND Whereas applicants for a Federal licence to cultivate or process cannabis are required to comply with municipal by-laws including zoning by-laws before a licence can be issued;

AND Whereas according to the City's Zoning By-law 0225-2007, the cultivation and processing of cannabis for medical purposes is a permitted use in employment zones;

AND Whereas when the zoning by-law was amended to allow cannibas production for medical purposes only, production for recreational purposes was not legal at that time;

Therefore be it Resolved:

That Council directs the Planning and Building Department to bring forward an amendment to the City's Zoning By-law 0225-2007 to permit the cultivation and processing of cannabis for both medical and recreational purposes in employment zones.
