#### **Expression of Sympathy**

WHEREAS the Mayor, Members of Council, the City's Leadership team and staff are very saddened to learn of the passing of Susan Burt on Sunday, January 19, 2020.

AND WHEREAS Susan joined the City in 1987 with the Community Services Department as Performing Arts Coordinator. She subsequently worked in a variety of leadership positions within Community Services as a Supervisor and then a Manager. In 2005 she provided support to the Mayor's Arts Review Task Force before returning to Community Services as Director, Park Planning and Development and Business Services.

AND WHEREAS in 2008 she became Mississauga's first Director of Culture, initially within City Manager's Office to champion the creation of the City's Culture Master Plan and then within Community Services in operationalizing the Plan. She assumed the role of Director of Strategic Community Initiatives within the Planning & Building Department in 2014 before retiring in October 2016.

AND WHEREAS Susan had a phenomenal 29 year career at the City, it is very difficult to overstate her achievements in community development, arts and culture and city building. Her uncompromising focus on building for the future and her advice to City Council, the Leadership Team and the departmental leadership teams she has participated in.

AND WHEREAS Susan was an indispensable source of insight and was hugely respected by her staff, peers, the community and the private sector.
