WHEREAS Motion 0159-2020 directed that a Request for Information be submitted to the Province for information related to the lobbyist registry and the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing lacked specificity;

AND WHEREAS research indicates the more detailed the FOI request, the more likely the information provided by the province will be expansive and productive;

AND WHEREAS the time frame of the request has been expanded given the length of time Senior levels of government take to complete studies and finalize decisions;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The Mayor and Council of the City of Mississauga make a Freedom of Information (FOI) request to the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing to include the following:

- Records of meetings with Steve Clark, Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing - or members of his staff - by registered lobbyists and developers [between January 1, 2019 and June 3, 2020](#) (the present) regarding the Region of Peel;
- Correspondence, including letters, emails, voice messages and any/all other forms of communication regarding the Region of Peel;
- Memoranda including briefing notes, background notes, issue notes, discussion notes and any other documents relevant to the Region of Peel;
- Meeting agendas, meeting minutes, meeting notes, regarding the Region of Peel;
- Reports, studies, maps or other documents prepared by staff or on behalf of staff, external consultants or representatives of developers with an interest in land holdings in the Region of Peel;
- All reports and other communications submitted by private individuals or entities to the Ministry in relation to lobbying activities related to development issues in the Region of Peel.
