 - 7.1. Proposed 2017 Cycling Network Program (Matthew Sweet, Active Transportation Coordinator, 15 minutes)

Mr. Sweet presented the proposed 2017 Cycling Network program. He outlined the characteristics of the active transportation connections to the BRT stations and that 58.8km's are proposed for 2017 Cycling Network Program.

Members of the Committee enquired about bike racks at BRT stations and the timing of the street light at Vista Road and Matheson Blvd. East. Staff noted that they would review construction concerns with the widening of the Creditview Road bridge.

Ben Gomberg, Manager, Active Transportation noted that staff would bring back a progress report mid-year on the 2017 Cycling Network Program.
