#### 4. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

4.1. Minutes of the September 6, 2016 meeting of the Environmental Action Committee

#### 5. **DEPUTATIONS**

5.1. Diana Gaspar spoke to the Committee regarding Green Drinks Mississauga.

Ms. Gaspar noted that Green Drinks is an international organization across hundreds of countries that organize monthly networking events to connect people with a green professional background or personal interest environmental issues such as professionals working for green companies or for environmental non-profits, entrepreneurs, government representatives, students, community builders, and citizens. Further, Ms. Gaspar provided information on Green Drinks Mississauga that has held 11 monthly events, has over 291 participants registering from 26 different cities, and will have its one-year anniversary in its current formation on December 13, 2016. With respect to future plans for Green Drinks Mississauga, Ms. Gaspar noted a Green Careers event to be held in the spring of 2017, possibly hosting an annual conference, and building relationships with contacts at the City.

Councillor Mahoney thanked Ms. Gaspar for her presentation.

5.2. Brenda Osborne, Director, Environment provided an overview of the Living Green Master Plan 2015 Progress Report, noting that it is a 10 year plan and that 2017 will be the halfway mark. Among highlights, Ms. Osborne commented that the One Million Trees program is up to approximately 220,000 trees planted, the waste reduction on Celebration Square, and food security in cooperation with Ecosource.

In response to a question from Councillor Tovey, Ms. Osborne noted that there is a decrease in the amount of waste and a decrease in the waste generated, at Celebration Square.

Brad Bass, Citizen Member inquired about transportation and a decrease in the number of cars, to which Ms. Osborne noted that the BRT (Bus Rapid Transit) would impact this.

Chelsea Dalton, Citizen Member inquired about recycling bins, to which Ms. Osborne encouraged Ms. Dalton to contact the Supervisor, Waste Management. Further Ms. Dalton inquired as to how many of the trees planted in the One Million Trees program had survived, to which Ms. Osborne noted she would check with Forestry staff. Eashan Karnik, UTM Student Member commented that he had been in contact with Forestry staff and that 86% of the trees have survived.

Pujita Verma, PEYA Member encouraged Environment Division staff to connect with youth in Mississauga.
