- 4.1. Application to permit a 28-storey, 268 unit apartment building, 45 Agnes Street
  Northeast corner of Cook Street and Agnes Street
  Eminence Living Inc.
  Recommendation Report Ward 7

Michael Hynes, Development Planner provided an overview of the application to permit a 28-storey, 268 unit apartment building at 45 Agnes Street.

Councillor lannicca spoke to the application and outlined intensification within the area.

The following residents made oral submissions citing concerns with the proposed development. The following concerns were discussed: condominium ownership versus rental units; potential safety concerns with the increased number of rental units; increased traffic congestion; increased insurance rates in the area; potential fire risks; and lack of natural light.

Councillor lannicca enquired what the difference is between rental and condominium built form. Ed Sajecki, Commissioner, Planning & Building responded.

Ruth Victor, Planner, Ruth Victor Associates spoke to the developer's intension to move forward with a condominium approval and that some units could be rented out by investors.

Leslie Green, Manager, Transportation Projects spoke to previous completed traffic studies within the area and outlined the current investment made to the transportation network in the area.

Councillor lannicca spoke to previous public meetings held; that Cooksville is currently going through a revitalization; and outlined the planned transportation infrastructure network.

Councillor Starr enquired who the Principals are for the property. John Matas and Sharief Zaman introduced themselves as the Principals of the property.

#### RECOMMENDATION

- 1. That the applications under File OZ 13/017 W7, 45 Agnes Street to amend Mississauga Official Plan to Residential High Density Special Site 3 (amended) and to change the zoning to RA4-27 (Apartment Dwellings Exception, amended) to permit a 28-storey, 282 unit residential apartment building with a maximum floor space index (FSI) of 7.5 in accordance with the proposed zoning standards, be approved subject to the conditions referenced in the staff report.
- 2. That the applicant agrees to satisfy all the requirements of the City and any other external agency concerned with the development.
- 3. That the decision of Council on the rezoning application be considered null and void, and a new development application be required unless a zoning by-law is passed within 18 months of the Council decision.
- 4. Notwithstanding subsection 45.1.3 of the *Planning Act*, subsequent to Council approval of the development application, the applicant can apply for a minor variance application, provided that the height and FSI shall remain the same.

#### 4.2. Tower Renewal Partnership Project

Councillor Fonseca expressed support of the renewal project and spoke to the need to continue consulting with the CMHC in anticipation of the National Housing Strategy report and the Official Plan Policy. She enquired if a list had been shared outlining what developers already build purpose built rentals. Andrew Whittemore, Director, Policy Planning Division responded.

Councillor Parrish enquired about the difference in operating costs between rental buildings and condominiums. Mr. Whittemore noted that staff would send her that information. She further enquired what it would cost to do a numeration of all the new high-rise buildings in the downtown core before the next election.

Ed Sajecki, Commissioner, Planning & Building spoke to renewal of towers and noted that sites need to be reviewed comprehensively.
