#### 4. MATTERS CONSIDERED

#### 4.1. Discussion of Pedestrian Safety Awareness Campaigns

Anna Ramlakhan, Citizen Member, spoke to the Vision Zero Pedestrian Working Group meeting held on June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at the Region of Peel.

Katya Seckar, Education Specialist, Environmental Education, Region of Peel spoke to statistics relating to collisions involving pedestrians and highlighted the following: driver action; vehicle maneuver to cause injury; driver condition; right of way; pedestrians age; and emergency room visits.

Members of the Committee engaged in a discussion regarding: crosswalk signals; collision statistics involving pedestrians; distracted driving; pedestrian attitudes and behaviours while walking; demographic age for campaign focus; campaigns to educate pedestrians and drivers; and promotional materials.

The Promotional Subcommittee spoke to the following ideas for campaigns:

- Messages on screensavers at the library
- Messages on washroom stalls
- Distribute cards/promotional materials at community centres
- Phone messages for 3-1-1 Call Centre
- Promotional videos
- Left/Right turn messages on mobile signs
- School bus ads and working with schools for education
- Working with Canadian Automobile Association (CAA) and Ministry of Transportation (MTO)

The committee spoke to left/right turns, distracted pedestrians and education on pedestrian safety for drivers and pedestrians as being the main areas of focus. The committee spoke to a deadline of July to come up with a plan to bring forward to the Region of Peel.

# 4.2. Anne Marie Hayes, Citizen Member, regarding promotional videos

Anne Marie Hayes, Citizen Member, spoke to using promotional videos for education and raising awareness. Ms. Hayes noted that when the committee is ready, she has a team who can work with the committee to create promotional videos at a reduced cost.
