New signage and line painting





MATTERS TO BE CONSIDERED

1. Review of the Walk to School Program (Re-launches)

Louise Goegan, advised that the re-launch at Artesian Public School, Plum Tree Park Public School, Shelter Bay Public School, all of which Traffic Safety Council had scheduled for a re-launch in the fall 2016, was successful. Traffic Safety Council was well represented and there were several students who walked to school.




