7. PARKING ENFORCEMENT REPORT

7.1 Parking Enforcement School Zone Report - February 2017

Michael Foley, Acting Manager, Parking Enforcement spoke to the new format of the Parking Enforcement School Zone Report, in which it now provides the wording for the related offence, not just a code, for ease of reference. 



On other occasions, we have crossed the entrance of the kiss and drive laneway and drivers have failed to wait for us to complete the crossing. Furthermore, these drivers often enter the laneway from our behind us.

I know that several parents have expressed their concern to the school, but I am not sure if they have contacted your office.

I would like to suggest that the police monitor the intersection, over the next several months, to help encourage drivers to be more careful.




