- 3.1. Michelle Berquist, Project Leader, Transportation Planning, provided an overview with respect to the Transportation Master Plan "Mississauga Moves", highlighting the project's plan, 3 phases, next steps and community engagement. Ms. Berquist further added that there are over 3 million trips daily in Mississauga, and that the majority of those trips are for other purposes, not for travelling to work or school.
