5.9. <u>Site Inspection Report – Streetsville Secondary School (Ward 11)</u>

Site Inspection Report for the safety review conducted on June 14, 2018 at the intersection of Thomas Street and McFarren/Gafney Drive, for the students attending Streetsville Secondary School.

RECOMMENDATION

- That Transportation and Works be requested to paint zebra markings around the intersection of Thomas Street and McFarren/Gafney Drive for the students attending Streetsville Secondary School.
- That Peel Regional Police be requested to enforce speeding on Thomas Street in the vicinity of Streetsville Secondary School during the peak times of 7:30 AM to 8:15 AM, as time and manpower permits.
- 3. That the Principal of Streetsville Secondary School be requested to remind students to cross Thomas Street at the intersection and to always activate the pedestrian button before crossing.

RECOMMEND APPROVAL

5.10. <u>Site Inspection Report – Whitehorn Public School and St. Raymond Catholic</u> Elementary School (Ward 6)

Recommendations
1) THAT TRANSPORTATION AND WORKS BE REQUESTED TO PAINT ZEBRA MARKINGS AROUND THE INTERSECTION.
2) THAT PEEL REGIONAL POLICE BE REQUESTED TO ENFORCE SPEEDING ON THOMAS STREET DURING THE PEAK TIMES OF 7:30 - 8:15 AM, AS TIME AND RESOURCES PERMIT.
3) THAT THE PRINCIPAL OF STREETSVILLE SECONDARY SCHOOL BE REQUESTED TO REMIND STUDENTS TO CROSS THOMAS STREET AT THE INTERSECTION AND TO ALWAYS ACTIVATE THE PEDESTRIAN BUTTON BEFORE CROSSING.
