#### Thanks for the update!

The road rehabilitation program is a large program involving many streets in the City. Through this program, road, curb and sidewalk infrastructure in need of refurbishment is included in the scope of work. Basically, the existing infrastructure is replaced (including possible upgrading if applicable... tactile plates for example). If there is an obvious or known change to be made, it will be made but otherwise the existing condition will be emulated. The works are also timed in order to avoid construction in school zones during the school season. In this instance, the work took place prior to the school season and prior to the Traffic safety review. There was no known reason to make a change so they were not included.

In future, it may be prudent for Traffic Safety to consider reviewing what school zones will have rehabilitation works and do a review prior to the construction work occurring. The construction program is posted online at the following link: <u>mississauga.ca/portal/residents/construction</u>. This may be a good topic for discussion at a future TSC meeting.

We are not sure the history of the sidewalk in question is. If the Traffic Safety Council recommends its removal for safety reasons, I would support that and recommend that the Councillor be updated accordingly and the works arranged as soon as possible. Since the issue has been raised by Councillor Fonseca and Geoff has asked that I respond, I will do that accordingly but need to confirm exactly what will be changed prior to confirming the game plan with the Councillor.

I would suggest the following:

- New school bus landing pad to be installed
- Sidewalk leading to curb cut in front of school be removed (boulevard portion between curb and regular sidewalk and full curb reinstated)

I would assume that Works will do these changes. Had the changes been known at the time of the resurfacing, I would suggest that EC do the work.

Let me know if I have missed anything, and Peter T, what would the timing of the works be?

I have copied a few others on this email as it is a good example for clarifying similar works in the future.

I will send a response to Councillor Fonseca once we firm up the game plan.

Further to our telephone conversation last week regarding a school bus landing pad on Flagship Drive in front of Dixie Public School, Peter Westbrook of Traffic Safety, Peter Terminesi and I met onsite this morning to determine the size and location of the pad. Peter Terminisi has put in a work order to install the school bus landing pad and I am putting in the work order for the signage to be added to existing poles.

There is a curb cut and landing pad with tactile plates that line up with a walkway that leads to the front of the school that is located about 15 feet east of the school crosswalk. It is a problem as

parents walk their students across the street at this location instead of crossing Flagship Drive with the crossing guard 15 feet away. It is not configured like a bus pad as there is a curb depression. Were you able to find out why it was placed there? We would very much like to have it removed for the safety of the students.
