If you are unable to walk your student the entire distance, it is suggested that you park a few blocks from the school and then walk the rest of the way.

If walking to school is not an option, here are some things you should know:

The school has a Kiss and Ride. However at (insert name of school) kindergarten students must be delivered as per the following:

 Parking spaces are available on school property for you to park your vehicle and then walk your student to the kindergarten area. Please use the sidewalks and designated crosswalks when walking on school property.

- There is no parking on school property. You must find legal parking on the street and walk your student to the kindergarten area ensuring that the student exits the vehicle on the sidewalk, not the roadway. Please use the sidewalks and designated crosswalks when walking on school property.
- There are designated persons available to take your student from your vehicle in the Kiss and Ride to the kindergarten area. Please use the Kiss and Ride to drop your child off with a designated kindergarten person. Please <u>do not</u> get out of your car in the Kiss and Ride lane and kindly observe all Kiss and Ride rules as posted.

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Walk to School Notes: Feb 2019

- 1. We are approaching Castlebridge Public School for a launch in the spring. If all goes well we will also approach the Our Lady of Mercy which is close to do a launch there as well.
- 2. We will do a relaunch at Ridgewood if they are agreeable.
- 3. When we see what the committee will look like a decision will be made as to how many relaunches that can be handled.
- 4. A request from Corpus Christi was made for us to participate in a walk about as they plan to launch their school with and STP working with the Region of Peel. They have asked for us to participate in an assembly for the students in March.
- 5. We were given an opportunity to participate in a focus group run by Metrolinx that looked at why students do or do not walk to school. Very interesting and insightful. Eight parents were behind a two way mirror and asked a number of questions on this subject. Many of the reasons seemed funny but it was a reality for these parents. One whose child was late for school every day said that she just couldn't get him up and then it was like pulling teeth to get him dressed and fed.. Another parent had 3 boys all going to different schools and there was no other way around it except to drive them. The full report from this hasn't been sent out yet but I will share when it is available.
- 6. A request from Councillor McFadden's ward for a display for a safety night has come in and we will be attending .
- 7. We have been working with the Peel board to develop an insert for the Kindergarten registration on developing strategies for getting these new registrants to school. It tells them what to do if they are walking or using the Kiss n Ride. This should be ready for insert into the registration package by this spring.
- 8. We have been working with Ridgewood School, Dave Marcotte, the Parks Department and Councillor Parrish's office on ways to improve and make safer the schools kiss n ride.
