If selected to participate, the criteria below outlines how performances will be assessed on the day of the poetry slam.

Scoring:

There will be three judges at the poetry slam. Scoring will be based on content, delivery, and impact for a score of up to (30) points, with (10) points in each category.

Penalties:

Time:

The maximum time for each performer is 3 minutes with a 10 second grace period. The timer will begin with the poet's initial contact with the audience. For poets that exceed this time limit, a (0.5) point penalty will be deducted (from the performer's average score) for every 10 seconds over 3:10:00, or part thereof. Therefore, for a performer's final time of 3:15:00, a (0.5) point penalty will apply; a final time of 3:25:00 will have a (1.0) point penalty, and so on.

Inappropriate or offensive content:

If the content of the poem is deemed inappropriate or offensive, or if the poem differs from the original work the performer submitted for screening, then the performer risks disqualification or a penalty that is up to the discretion of the judges.

Calculation of Final Scores:

The points will be averaged across the three judges. Any penalties will be deducted from the average score to produce the final scores. The top (3) performers with the highest final scores will be recognized as champions of the Poetry Slam.*

*Note: To respect each individual performer, final scores will not be released or published.
