Ballet Scrunchie



MATERIALS REQUIRED:

Tulle/Fabric
(dance costume
or ribbon)

Hair
Elastic(s)

Scissors
(adult supervision
recommended)

Ballet Scrunchie



1) Find an old dance costume that has a tulle tutu (skirt) or other reusable fabric; be creative with your colours and fabrics to show your personality!

2) Using a pair of sharp scissors, cut off large pieces of tulle/fabric to be used for cutting down into smaller pieces.

Adult supervision recommended for all fabric cutting! NOTE: If you don't have old dance costumes at home, you can check out your local second-hand store or purchase tulle ribbon from craft supply stores



3) Using your larger pieces of fabric, cut them into 1 inch by 6 inch strips; you will need approximately 45-55 strips depending on the size of your hair elastic.

4) Take 1 strip of fabric at a time and knot each strip on to the hair elastic. Try your best to create the knot in the middle of the fabric strip (to ensure even ends). Continue to knot the strips around the hair elastic until it is entirely covered.

5) Position the ends of your tulle strips so they are all pointing in the same direction, outwards from the hair elastic. Using scissors, trim the ends of the tulle to make them equal lengths.



6) Show off your new bun cover in your hair or even use it to spice up a pencil holder! See below for our dancer model!
