BALLET DOOR HANGER

Upcycle a costume to create a 'ballet dancer' door hanger to show off your eye for fashion!



MATERIALS

- Paint/Markers/Crayons/Pastels • Tape
- Scissors • Glue • Cardboard • Tulle • Ribbon
- Decorations (stickers, rhinestones etc)

BALLET DOOR HANGER

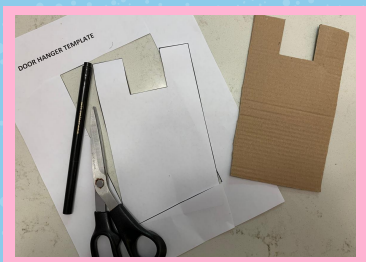
1) Print the door hanger template (see last page) on a piece of Letter sized (8.5 inch by 11 inch) printer paper and cut out along the lines.

(parental supervision recommended for all scissor use if/where required)

2) Trace the template on to a piece of cardboard and cut it out to create the bodysuit.

3) Paint, colour and decorate your bodysuit. Be creative and show off your own style!

NOTE: Keep in mind that the bottom inch of your bodysuit may be covered up.

4) Using an old costume, cut off tulle/fabric from the costume into a large rectangular piece approximately 5.5 inches by 20 inches.

TIP: You can also find tulle rolls at your local craft supply store



5) Starting at one end, create 6-7 folds approximately 0.5 inches each back and forth (like an accordion) and staple your folds as you go to hold in place; continue to repeat this process for the entire length of the tulle (what will become the skirt!)

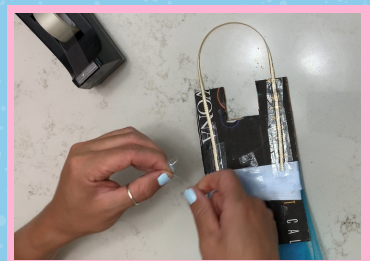

6) Tape the folded and stapled piece of tulle to the decorated body suit to create a skirt. Add a second layer of tulle if you want a fuller skirt.

7) Glue a wide piece of ribbon to cover the seam of the skirt.



8) Tape a piece of ribbon to the back of the bodysuit to create a hanger (you can also use a hole punch to create holes and tie your ribbon).
