JOHNNY MAX OF THE JOHNNY MAX BAND

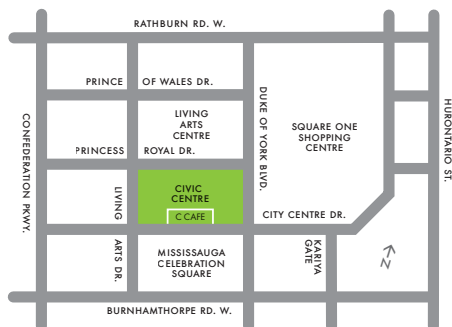

GEORGE HUNTER: A RETROSPECTIVE OF 'CANADA'S LOCATION PHOTOGRAPHER'

Mississauga's George Hunter's remarkable images span seven decades and create memorable impressions of people and places from across Canada and more than 100 countries world-wide. Appointed to the Royal Canadian Academy of the Arts in 1977 and widely published, his work includes photo spreads in TIME Magazine and a major exhibit by the National Film Board of Canada. His prints are found in permanent collections across Canada and locally in the Art Gallery of Mississauga. Stories from a lifetime of photography and images from Hunter's iconic career will be shared with the cafe audience by two contemporary artists, Tom Bochsler and Ken Clayton.
