- Paper moccasin
- Yarn

What you need from home

- Colouring tools
- Scissors

A moccasin is a type of shoe made of deerskin that was originally worn by First Nations Peoples. Different First Nations designed and wore different styles of moccasins. This style of moccasin was worn by the Anishinaabe. Moccasins were often decorated with floral patterns made out of porcupine quills and later glass beads.

What to do

Step 1: Colour your moccasin on the side that has the printed lines and draw some floral decorations on it. You will need to colour the flaps with the fringe on the backside (not where the lines are printed).



Step 3: Fold the moccasin on the dashed lines.

Step 4: Pull the two sides together and use the yarn to lace through the holes on the front and back of the moccasin.
