- Assist the Chef in maintaining inventory levels of kitchen service equipment and supplies
- Prepare warming carts for plated meal service and assist in plating food for banquet functions
- Receive, unpack, and store kitchen deliveries in designated storage areas
- Monitor and replenish kitchen cleaning supplies as needed
- Assist with light food preparation and cooking
