NEW FUNDING FOR 2 HOSPITALS

Mississauga MPPs gathered at Credit Valley Hospital on Thursday, Jan. 30 to announce new provincial funding of \$4.6 million for Trillium Health Partners, which oversees three hospitals in Mississauga and Etobicoke. MPP Sheref Sabawy was joined by Peel MPPs Rudy Cuzzetto, Natalia Kusendova, Nina Tangri as well as Christine Hogarth (Etobicoke-Lakeshore) and CEO of Trillium Health Partners Michelle DiEmanuele. The funding will be used to maintain and upgrade hospital infrastructures and to fund repairs.

"These investments will help ensure that patients in Mississauga, Etobicoke and across Peel can receive the care they need in a safe and comfortable setting," said Sabawy

in a release. Credit Valley Hospital will receive the bulk of the funding, about \$3.3 million, followed by Mississauga Hospital with a total of \$975,000 and Etobicoke's Queensway Health Centre with \$400,000. Upgrades will be made to the nurse call system at both Credit Valley and Mississauga Hospital, while Queensway Health Centre will have their elevator system upgraded, among other projects. The funding is part the Health Infrastructure Renewal Fund, which will see a government investment of \$175 million across 131 hospitals this year.
