# Ready TO READ

## Early Literacy Begins With You.

You are your child's first teacher and your home is where your child begins to learn. Learning to read begins before children start school. Developing early literacy skills will make it easier for children to read once they begin school. Help your child get ready to read with these simple activities every day.



### Talking

Talking with children is one of the best ways to help them learn new words and information.



### Playing

Children learn a lot about language through play. Playing helps children express themselves and put thoughts into words and to think symbolically.



### Reading

Reading together is the single most important way to help children get ready to read.



### Singing

Singing, which also includes rhyming, increases children's awareness of the sounds in words. This helps prepare children to read print.



### Writing

Writing and reading go together. Scribbling and writing help children learn that letters and words stand for sounds and that print has meaning.
